The entire student body will vote for the Court. The Court will consist of the six girls with the highest number of votes. The Queen will be the girl receiving the most votes out of the six selected. If you wish to nominate a girl for the 2020 Homecoming Court, follow the calendar and the instructions below. *Due to the current pandemic, all events and dates are subject to change.*

- Friday, August 28 Deadline for turning in the following:
 - (a) Nomination form (attached)
 - (b) Permission letter (attached)
 - (c) Nominee profile (attached)
- Monday, August 31 Pictures will be taken of all girls nominated: 4:00 P.M. in the Auditorium. Wear school uniform including sweater or jacket. Pictures will not be returned. Pictures must not be altered in any way; asking the studio to do this automatically forfeits a girl's right to run for the Court.
- Tuesday, September 8 Nominees' pictures and profiles will be posted after school.
- Thursday, September 10th and Friday, September 11 Student body votes for Queen and Court. Winners will be contacted by phone after 4:00 p.m. on Friday.
- Monday, September 14 The Court will be announced to the school.
- Thursday, September 24 The Court will have a mandatory meeting at 4:00 P.M. in room 114.
- Pep Rally DATE TBD The Court will be presented to the student body at a pep rally in the Conlin Gym (8:00 A.M.). You will receive more information at the September 24th meeting. (Due to the current pandemic and gathering restrictions, a pep rally may or may not take place. As the date approaches, we will discuss this possibility)
- Halftime Presentation DATE TBD We hope to present the court during the half-time activities at one of the Brother Martin football games. The LHSAA has announced that October 9th is the first possible playing date, but the first game could be later. Once the first playing date is confirmed, the entire schedule will be adjusted. We cannot announce a date for Homecoming until that time. If the 2020 Fall football season does not take place, we will present the homecoming court at a Brother Martin basketball game (if basketball is allowed to play in the winter).
- Saturday, January 16 The Queen and Court will be presented at 9:30 P.M. at the Homecoming Dance. The dance will be held at the Pontchartrain Center from 8:00 P.M. until 11:30 p.m. The Court must arrive by 8:15 P.M. for pictures.

 (Due to the current pandemic and gathering restrictions, the dance may or may not take place. As the date approaches, we will discuss this possibility)

Once the six girls are elected, each girl is expected to participate in all of the activities listed above, or forfeit her opportunity to participate in Brother Martin's Homecoming Activities. Failure to have a picture taken on the specified day at Brother Martin automatically forfeits a girl's right to run for the Court.
