## Cook-Off Rules

1. There is a \$25 entry fee per team. Entry Fee must be received by Friday, September 23, 2022. Please register early; **space is limited**. Beer and drink tickets included.
2. Teams will consist of no more than four people. Each team may enter one dish. Any substitute team members must be verified by the Event Committee. Each team will receive 4 event entry tickets. Team uniforms are encouraged but are not required.
3. You must notify the committee if you are a chef or professional cook at the time of registration.
4. You will not have access to the Brother Martin Food Service kitchen at any time.
5. You will be provided with a 12 x 12 plot in the Backyard.
6. There will be two categories: "**People's Choice Award**" and "**Judge's Gold Ribbon Award**."
7. **You are responsible for all of your ingredients, utensils, water, towels, cooking tools, tables, pits, grills, and stoves. You must be a self-sustained cooking station.**
8. All ingredients must be brought in separately, uncooked, and unprepared.
9. You will have 30 minutes to set up your station, then you will have 3 hours to prepare your dish. Once cooking begins, you will not be allowed to bring in any other ingredients. Food prep has to be completed in the time limit.
10. All cooking must be done in a sanitary manner. These conditions are subject to inspection by the Event Committee, and failure to comply is subject to disqualification. **NO GLASS CONTAINERS** will be allowed.
11. You must make at least 100 portions of your dish. Each dish will be donated for consumption at the event. Each team is expected to dispense its dish to the public after the judging samples have been collected. Brother Martin will supply paper products and plastic ware.
12. The dish will be judged on taste by the panel of judges. Awards will be given to top dishes and "People's Choice Award."
13. Each team will receive a special gift.

**You will be allowed to enter the Backyard/Terrace at  
7:30 a.m. and begin cooking at 8:00 a.m. on October 2.  
All dishes and brews must be ready at 11:00 a.m.**
