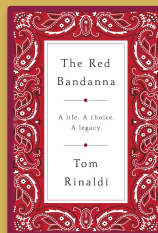
Homecoming Shirts on Sale

As Penguin Books describes, *The Red Bandana* tells the true story of Welles Crowther, a young man working in the South Tower of the World Trade Center on September 11. Crowther sacrificed his own life while helping others escape, repeatedly climbing nearly twenty flights of stairs to guide strangers to safety.

Through Welles Crowther's story, we hope our students gain a deeper understanding of September 11 and, most importantly, recognize the lasting example of courage, compassion, and service to others demonstrated in the face of unimaginable circumstances.
